



WHAT CAN THE POLICE DO FOR YOU?

- Respond to your call as soon as possible;
- Prevent violence;
- Arrest the offender;
- Provide safety and security for you and other family members;
- Provide legal protection;
- Provide medical support;
- Provide shelter;
- Handle the case in cooperation with the Centre for Social Welfare, victim advocate and other stakeholders;
- Investigate the case in coordination with the prosecutor.



YOU (THE VICTIM) HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- 
- Live happily;
 - Live free of fear;
 - Report domestic violence at the nearest police station;
 - Be treated with dignity;
 - Receive free of charge legal assistance;
 - Receive immediate protection;
 - Apply for shelter at the Violence Victims Centre;
 - Request compensation for the damage caused.
