OUR CAPITAL PRISTINA HOSTING THE 42nd CONFERENCE, THE POLICE DIRECTORS OF 26 EUROPEAN CAPITALS GUESTS AT THIS EVENT

The Conference of Police Directors of European Capitals is an annual event that brings together the Police Chiefs of European capitals, since its first edition, held in 1979 in the city of London. Kosovo, respectively the Pristina Regional Police Directorate, participated in this conference since 2016, first as an observer in Budapest (Hungary), and then as an equal member in 2017 in Lisbon (Portugal).

BORDER POLICE RECEIVED A DONATION FROM THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT



On December 8, 2022, the Kosovo Police in the premises of the General Directorate, in a handover ceremony, received a donation from the German Government in the amount of 500 thousand euros. In this ceremony, in addition to the acting General Director of the Kosovo Police Mr. Hoti and the senior management of KP, the German ambassador Mr. Rohde and the Minister of Internal Affairs Mr. Sveçla were

present. This donation to the Kosovo Police is dedicated to the Border Police and contains 10 ATVs - vehicles (4X4 for patrolling in all types of terrain), laptops, as well as other professional equipment for border surveillance and control. In addition to the donation offered, the German ambassador emphasized that the cooperation and partnership established over the years will continue and expressed the

readiness of the German Government to help the Kosovo Police in the future. In this case the acting General Director of the KP expressed his gratitude to the ambassador and the German Embassy for the close cooperation and support for the Kosovo Police in building capacities through continuous donations as a strategic partner of the KP.

OUR CAPITAL PRISTINA, HOSTING THE DIRECTORS OF 26 EUROPEAN CAPITALS



The Conference of Police Directors of European Capitals is an annual event that brings together the Chiefs of Police of European capitals, since its first edition, held in 1979 in the city of London. Kosovo, respectively the Regional Police Directorate of Pristina, has participated in this conference since 2016, first as an observer in Budapest (Hungary), and then as an equal member in 2017 in Lisbon (Portugal). In 2018 in Dublin, Ireland, it was decided that this conference would be held in Pristina in 2020, but it was canceled due to the covid 19 pandemic, which was organized two years later in



October 2022.

The Regional Police Directorate of Pristina was the host and organizer of this conference, with the participation of directors and representatives of 26 police organizations of European capitals. At the opening of this conference, the director of Pristina Regional Directorate, lieutenant colonel Fehmi Xhata, presented to the audience a summary of the development stages over the years of the Kosovo Police and the Regional Directorate of Pristina in particular. Among other things, the regional director conveyed a message that the Kosovo Police is

open to cooperation with all the police organizations of the participating countries and beyond, as well as expressed the objective of membership in international organizations, where support was also requested.

During the sessions, there were presentations from most European countries as well as from Kosovo. Police officers of specialized units, the field of cybercrime investigation, who presented to the participants the achievements and the professional level of these units.



This will affect the strengthening of international cooperation and partnership in the field of security and the exchange of advanced experiences.



The 42nd conference of police directors of European capitals has successfully closed its works by signing of the joint declaration by the participating states, with ten points drawn from the topics covered and the discussions throughout the conference.

In order for the participants to get to know the capital of Kosovo better, as part of the agenda there was also a visit to some of the places of particular importance, related to the culture and history of the Republic of Kosovo, such as the Ethnological Museum, the Newborn Monument, The Heroinat Memorial, the Mother Teresa Cathedral as well as the National Library, where the participants had the opportunity to visit and hear through guides about the monuments/places and their history.



The purpose of this conference was precisely the international cooperation and partnership in the field of security and the exchange of experiences, where a joint statement was signed by the participating states, this agreement consisting of ten points derived from the topics addressed and the discussions throughout the conference.

Albania was chosen as the country where the next conference will be held, i.e. the 43rd in a row, while Estonia will be the hosting country after Albania.

Organizers of this event were a group of officers from the Regional Police Directorate of Pristina.

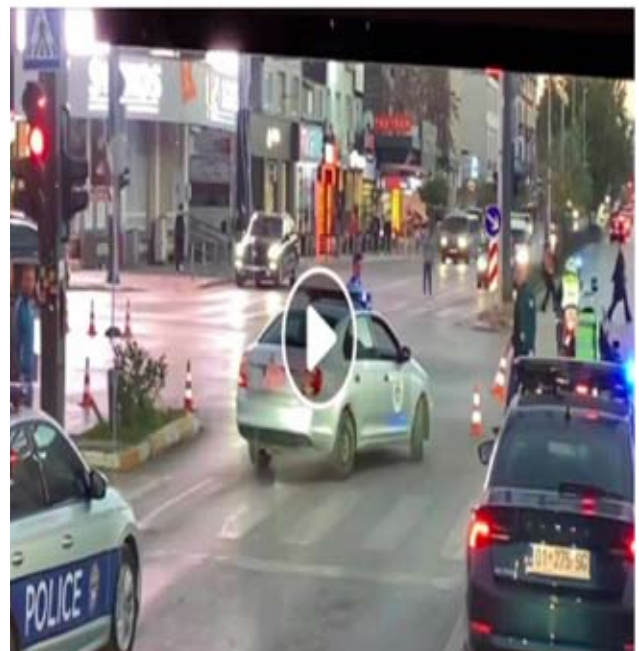

Representatives of the information offices from the Kosovo Institutions visited Netherlands



On December of this year, the representatives of the offices for public information and media of Kosovo Police, Special Prosecution office, Prosecution Council of Kosovo and Kosovo Judicial Council carried out a study visit in Hague. The agenda included the visits to:

- Europol
- Specialized Chambers of Kosovo
- International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals

The purpose of the visit was to be closely informed about the strategy of communication and their sensitization programs. The participants were warmly welcomed by the ambassador of the Republic of Kosovo in Netherlands who talked about the priorities and engagement fields of this embassy.



THE CIVILIAN STAFF, A SUPPORT PILLAR FOR KOSOVO POLICE

In Kosovo Police, except the uniformed officers there also work civilian staff who are a very strong and supportive pillar for the Institution.

The civilian staff of Kosovo Police perform administrative and supportive services, but doesn't have police authorizations.

The official Xhevahire Berisha – Uka is the first official employed as a civilian staff in Kosovo Police.

Emotionally, she described us her entire journey in the Police.

Xhevahirja was born and raised in Prishtina, she finished primary school at the “Asim Vokshi” school in Prishtina, while the high school (after a period of learning at home “school”, during the war) she finished it at “Sami Frashëri” school

She studied at the Faculty of Education in Prishtina - Information Technology at the University of Pristina.

Officer Berisha-Uka started working in the Police at a very young age, deciding to challenge herself and pave the way for her dreams: “the year 2000 was the year I started working, shortly after the establishment of our institutions. I had the pleasure of be the first civil staff officer employed in the Kosovo Police with ID card number 0001

I felt appreciated, self-confident and full of will that as a young woman I got a job. I was even more pleased with the fact that from now on I would serve in a reliable institution such as the Police.

The official Xhevahire Berisha – Uka is the first official employed as a civilian staff in Kosovo Police. Emotionally, she described us her entire journey in the Police.



At first I started to work at the Directorate of Personnel in the File Room. After 3 years of experience in studies and training in the field of Technology, in 2003 I moved to the Department of Information and Communication Technology. Since then I continued to be part of the wonderful ICT staff”.

She emphasized that in addition to the privilege and the good feeling that her work has given and gives her, she also has many responsibilities and mentioned how the first civil official wanted to be a good example for those who were hired afterwards, giving a lot from herself.

From the 22 year experience in the Police, she mentioned a lot of special moments: “In general, every day she was very good and special, characterized by different and often challenging natures.”

The job profile of our official is of a special importance, especially nowadays where the development of

technology has taken off and digitization in many spheres is the easiest solution for providing services to citizens.

In the ICT department where she works, her task is to maintain and administer applications by which the Kosovo Police manages and develops daily work both internally and in the field.

“I feel very good! The fact that I am still part of the Police shows that I like the work I do, I admire it and I take every task with dedication and seriousness.

Technology itself is a field that always shows innovation, so it makes you not get bored because the work does not become routine.

In addition to studies in Information Technology, Xhavehire has also completed various trainings in this field as well as many seminars inside and outside the country.

Appreciating the institution where she works, she has decided to give her 22 years of experience and contribution to the Police with pleasure.

She is married, mother of four daughters, and the family is what, apart the sacrifice, fulfills her spiritually! Even today she is proud of the Kosovo Police!

The heroism

HEROISM OF POLICE OFFICERS DURING THE WORK

The members of Kosovo Police during their everyday work continuously faces with unexpected cases. Every day of work, the police officers face with unknown difficulties but they always work with responsibility and humanity. During 2021, in a complicated case,

three police officers reacted with all the physical, professional, psychological and human forces to reach the big goal. On 28.06.2021, the Police Station "South" received an information that in a collective building, in the third floor,

a person was threatening to commit suicide. Upon receiving the information, the police units and the investigators responded the case. By the order of the commander of the Special Operation Unit, the Captain Fatmir Balaj who is trained for negotiations and two other police officers, Sergeant Rrahman Berisha and the operator Fisnik Gashi (member of SOU) immediately responded the scene to assist in the "suicide attempt" case.

Using their professional skills, especially the psychologic-physical negotiation abilities, passing from a balcony to another using accessories/ropes and other safety means, have managed to save the life of a citizen who threatened to end his life by jumping from the building.

The extraordinary actions of police officers in the right time, saved the life of the citizen, who was provided the medical and psychological

help.

They did this humanitarian act without being in regular working hours, feeling the responsibility and giving meaning to the epithet they bear.

Regarding this act, the Ministry of Internal Affairs in coordination with Kosovo Police awarded the above members with the "LIFE SAVING" medal.

Police is proud by the unsparred will and professional work of its officers.

The organization is grateful to its employees who continuously increases the value, reliability and professionalism.

The 20th meeting of the Executive Council of Local Committees for Public Safety (LCPS) was held.

Kosovo Police as an institution of maintaining public order and peace, within its authorizations and daily tasks, as a priority has the partnership with the citizens where continuously aims to increase and strengthen this cooperation. In the wake of carrying out this activity and with the aim

of increasing and strengthening the Local Committees for Public Safety on December 09, in cooperation with the Local Committee for Public Safety in Obiliq and with continuous support of OSCE, was held the 20th meeting of LCPS-s in local level, officer from the Agency for Managing Emergencies,

Police Officers etc. In this meeting, were revealed the projects of LCPS-s, letters of recognition were awarded by OSCE to the representatives of the LCPS-s, there were mentioned the challenges and recommendations that all the participants give their contribution on increasing the safety in general.

IMPRESSIONS AND PRIDE DURING THE HELD IN THE UNITED



A special highlight during this organization was that for the first time in the United Arab Emirates at the end of the training, during the graduation ceremony attended by the ambassador of Kosovo, among the flags of the participating countries, was the Kosovo flag as well.

During the period September-November 2022, with the initiative of the former-president Jahjaga and the Government of Kosovo, the intensive training with the topic "Women, peace and safety" for the women in police and military, was held. This meeting was organized by the "WOMEN" organization and there participated 15 countries of the world, including Kosovo for the first time.

157 officers from Arab countries such

as Africa and Asia participated, who carried out an intensive military training in the Military School "Khawla bint Al Azwar, inside the base of United Arab Emirates Armed Forces.

During the training, the participants spent eight-week military training and two weeks theoretical part for functioning of the UN as well as the peacekeeping missions.

The training courses included weapon

handling, simulated shooting with short and long weapons, real shooting with weapons, first aid under fire and use of first aid equipment in which the NATO soldiers as well as UN mission troops are trained, topography or map orientation, compass as well as technological equipment such as GPS, defense tactics such as Jiu-Jitsu as well as exercises and training (combats and drills) to be prepared and ready in conflict areas.

The purpose of the training was to prepare participants with physical, military and psychological skills to be part of United Nations (UN) peacekeeping missions in post-conflict areas, which areas can be some of the most hostile parts of the world, from the effects of war, where ceasefires can be fragile.

Part of the training was also the physical exercises as well as the parade of the participants with choreography for the final ceremony.

This training is the beginning of the initiative for the women from Kosovo to help and contribute to the general security in the world as well as to the security of the victims of the conflict in

the world.

A special highlight during this organization was that for the first time in the United Arab Emirates at the end of the training, during the graduation ceremony attended by the ambassador of Kosovo, among the flags of the participating countries, was the Kosovo flag as well.

Increasing the representation of women in peacekeeping missions is essential, given that half of the world's population are women and children. Although women are increasingly playing an important role in UN peacekeeping missions, progress still needs to be made.

During the training, through interviews for different media in the United Arab Emirates, the values and capacities of the KP and KSF that they can offer as contributors to peace in the world were promoted.

Major Luljeta Mehmeti Quigley from Kosovo Police in one of these interviews for "The National" television, among others, emphasized: "The importance of women's participation

in UN peacekeeping missions is more important than ever before, women peacekeepers can bring a different perspective and they are capable of serving just like men anywhere in any peacekeeping mission. The people of Kosovo and myself as well, have personally experienced the war and its consequences, so we better understand and feel the importance of peacekeeping missions for people when they need help"

She thanked the United Arab Emirates for the opportunity given to women from Kosovo to be part of this training, making this as a first step for women from Kosovo to join the peacekeeping missions of the United Nations and contribute to peace and security in the world.

In addition to the experience and lessons during this course, Major Luljeta has shown us that the bond of friendship between the participants, exchanging knowledge about traditions and customs, has left impressions.

Operations

Two suspects arrested for being involved in criminal offense “money counterfeit”



The police investigators from the Directorate for the Investigation of Economic Crimes and Corruption (DHKEK), supported by other law enforcement institutions and in coordination with the Basic Prosecutor in Ferizaj, on 09.12.2022 conducted a police operation for the arresting of the two suspects.

The arrest came as a result of an operative and investigative work, as the police had tracked down the suspects and on the respective date resulted in the red-handed arrest of two suspects: B.S., (dob 1986, Kosovar male) and M.L., (dob 1986, male Citizen of the Republic of North Macedonia). The suspects were trying to put into circulation an amount of counterfeit money with a total value of 53,100 (fifty three thousand one hundred euros) and 10,000 (ten thousand US dollars).

During this operation, the home of the suspected Kosovar citizen was searched as well. As material evidence that will be used in further proceedings, the following were seized:

700x50 € = 35000 €,
181x100 € = 18100 €,
100x100 US dollars,
2 cars and
3 phones.

All actions were carried out by the authorization of the chief prosecutor of the Basic Prosecutor's Office in Ferizaj and by his decision the suspects were taken to detention for 48 hours.



Two suspects arrested, drugs and ammunition are confiscated

The police investigators of the unit from the Directorate for the Investigation of Narcotics Trafficking in Peja, as a result of the investigation of an earlier case during which special measures were applied, after an operative-investigative work in the field, on 06.12.2022 conducted a fast-tactical operation coded “Lightning”. In this operation the GOLF-VII car, blue in color, driven by suspect no. 1, was stopped; N.D (1975 Kosovar male), where the passenger was the other suspect no. 2; B.K (1973 Kosovar male).

After the search on the body of the suspect no. 1, a quantity of suspected narcotic substance Heroin was found and confiscated and in consultation with the on duty prosecutor and by order of the Prosecutor's Office, a search was conducted at the suspects' houses, where the following relevant evidence were found and confiscated:

- Cocaine weighing 234.3 grams,
- Heroin weighing 412.6 grams,
- Twenty-nine (29) 9mm cartridges, as well as
- Three (3) mobile phones.

It is suspected that the narcotic substances were intended for the local market. The suspects were interviewed in the presence of defense lawyers and,

by order of the prosecutor, they were detained for 48 hours.

Kosovo Police remains committed to the prevention of all negative phenomena and criminal offenses in the country, an uncompromising war will be waged especially against those who deal with the abuse of narcotic substances.

The person wanted by Interpol is arrested

The Regional Police Directorate in Gjilan, the Regional Road Traffic Unit on 26.11.2022 at around 20:50 minutes on Kamenica road at a routine radar



checkpoint stopped a vehicle with local plates (01) driven by A. A. Kosovo Citizen due to violating the speed limit. The very same person, after being verified by the police officials, it turned out that he is wanted list by Interpol due to the criminal offense of “serious theft” committed outside the state of Kosovo. He was arrested by the police officers and brought to the Gjilan Police Station for further legal proceedings.

“Domestic violence” reported, two fireweapon seized

On 5th of December 2022 at around 4:40 p.m., a case of “Domestic Violence” was reported at the Suhareka Police Station in the village of Mushtisht.

The relevant police unit responds to the reported case, patrol units, those of investigations and the investigator of “Domestic Violence” cases arrived at

the scene and responded appropriately. The suspect E.M. is identified (46 years old), who is arrested due to the suspicion that he systematically used "Violence" against his family members. The suspect threatens to kill his wife.

During further legal actions by the police investigators, two firearms were found at the scene, respectively in one of the rooms in the suspect's house; a pistol, a rifle and 16 cartridges which were later seized as material evidence.

Criminal proceedings have been initiated against the suspect for the offense "Domestic Violence" as well as "Unauthorized ownership, control or possession of weapons".



Realted to this, the State Prosecutor is notified with a written decision in which the suspect is ordered to be taken to detention for 48 hours.

Kosovo Border Police prevents two cases of smuggling in goods

Kosovo Police, the Task Force police unit from the Regional Directorate of Border Police (DRPK) East, in implementation of measures to prevent and fight illegality and smuggling, have intensified it's tactical checks and field operations.

The Task Force unit at the DRPK-East has undertaken the necessary operational-tactical measures by organizing ambushes and checks on the roads of the border belt and secondary and regional roads, where as a result two cases of smuggling of goods have been prevented.

Case I: On 29.11.2022 at around 15:20 the Task Force unit noticed a suspect vehicle

entering the territory of the RKS from the village of Breznica, Republic of Serbia.

The same vehicle was followed and stopped in Gjilan at about 16:05 with the driver A. A. a Kosovar male, known to the Police as a recidivist of the criminal offenses of smuggling goods.

During the inspection, there were found about 300 kg loaded in the trunk of the car and the back seats that happen to be processed fruits (dried plums) for which there was no documentation on their origin and content. These dried fruits are suspected to have been brought from the Republic of Serbia.

Case 2: On 29.11.2022 at about 21:00 the Task Force, stopped a gray BMW X5 vehicle in the village of Stubëll, the municipality of Vitia with local license plates with the driver K. M. Kosovar male coming from North Macedonia with the suspicion of smuggling in goods, the person responsible for these goods J. K. Kosovar male

During the inspection of the vehicle, it was found that there were about 15 bags of processed tobacco loaded, which the suspects had taken in the Republic of North Macedonia.



The suspects planned to send the goods to a person in a village in the municipality of Vitia, where the Task Force unit identified the third person in the case, from whose house 10 identical tobacco bags were also seized.

The state prosecutor was notified of all these actions, who ordered that the cases be initiated as 'smuggling of goods', and that the goods be seized and sent to Customs.

The cases are being handled by the relevant police units from the East Regional Border Directorate in cooperation with the State Prosecutor's Office and Kosovo Customs

53 massage salons have been inspected, 44 have been closed during a Police operation together with the competent inspectors

Kosovo Police, respectively the Directorate for the Investigation of Human Trafficking, in the series of undertaking proactive measures and verify information in the field, drafted an operational plan to Inspect of Massage Salons, a plan which was carried out in cooperation and support of Inspectors from MINT, TAK and Labor Inspectors. On 07.12.2022, the Operative Plan coded "Massage - December -2022", was implemented at the level of the country and was completed successfully.

The preventive activities and the results of this operation are summarized in tabular form below:

Stop domestic violence

Kosovo Police in a 16 days campaign against domestic violence

The Kosovo Police, as a law enforcement institution within the framework of its duties and authorizations, since its establishment, has treated cases of domestic violence with due seriousness. The police has continuously carried out awareness raising campaign about the consequences of domestic violence, emphasizing that violence does not stop without being reported and treated by the competent bodies. Considering their sensitivity, the police's approach towards the cases of domestic violence is; the prevention of violence on the one

hand, as well as dealing more seriously with these cases, resulted in the increased number or reporting of such cases over the years. Following the implementation of activities, aiming to prevent such cases, on 25.11.2022, the Kosovo Police, in cooperation with the UN-Women office, begun the implementation of the awareness raising campaign "16 days of activism against domestic violence". This campaign will be carried out through the distribution of promotional material - flyers, which contain advice on taking measures to prevent domestic

violence as well as reporting these cases to Kosovo Police that carry the message "Stop domestic violence". These flyers will be distributed to citizens of all cities of Kosovo regardless of age.

This sensitization campaign will continue until December 10, 2022 with various sensitization activities, such as: informative meetings with citizens, lectures in school institutions, meetings at the level of state institutions, being aware for the important and contributing segment such as the engagement of civil society.



INFORMATION MANUAL FOR FACILITATING COMMUNICATION BETWEEN KOSOVO POLICE AND DEAF PEOPLE

The guide serves to notify deaf/semi-deaf drivers of the reason for their stopping and at the same time serves for other needs for help for the members of this community, also in special cases through the manual that each deaf/semi-deaf driver will carry with them- will be provided communication through interpreter.

Since the launch of this application, about (10,700) different cases related to road traffic, possession of weapons, drugs, cases of violence, corruption, etc. have been reported to the Police at the level of the country. By highly appreciating the cooperation with the citizens and the reports through this platform, Kosovo Police thanks citizens for reporting various cases and the cooperation offered

in achieving common objectives in guaranteeing general security. Police also encourages all citizens regardless, in all regions police, especially in the North Mitrovica region, so that the cases be reported without hesitation in the easiest and most accessible way for them.

All reports by citizens through this application provide complete transparency, confidentiality and anonymity. In the attachments in the languages (Albanian and Serbian) you have two awareness raising videos, awareness brochures, the module with explanations on how to download and use the "REPORT THE POLICE" application ".
